On the hottest day of the year, a very good entry. Thank you. Because of the heat I tried to keep the dogs out of the sun as much as possible, especially in the big classes. My critiques were made quickly and are not as full as usual.

PD (2, 1) 1 Fisher Shellamoyed Secret Blend 11-month-old of correct size and good proportions. Carrying a lot of puppy coat which makes him look a little stuffy in neck. I'd prefer a little more fill in muzzle. Carried himself well. BPIB

JD (5, 1) 1 Mitchell Valdosta Je Amour 15-month-old tri who appealed for shape and balance here. He is a very good mover with light and scopey stride. Scored in head proportions over 2nd very good ear placement and sweet expression. BJIB 2 Walker Cuilshelties Touch of Class with Grandgenes 13-month-old blue of lovely colour. Good proportions, ribcage and bone. He moved well. I liked his flat skull and ears a little heavy and I preferred expression of winner. 3 Melvin & Jopson Nithview The Driffter

YD (4, 0) A good class with 3 quality dogs at the top 1 Stafford Rannerdale Jammy Dodger 15-month-old sable in excellent coat. He is a little long for balance. His head is well balanced and his eye and expression appealed. Best movement of the class with light and seemingly effortless ground coverage. 2 Naulls Wynele Final Impact 20-month-old sable/white top size but has good outline and movement. Scored in neck and eye colour to gain this place. 3 Keeling Kishdigra The Love God RAF

PGD (7, 2) 1 Walker Tooralie's Tornade JW 4-year-old black/white who won this class well. Masculine head, without coarseness and with very good balance, eye and ears. He is strongly boned. A lovely mover, made the last 4 in the challenge. 2 Bird & Caden Moving On Up to Molson almost 2-year-old but on the move refined lines I liked his balance and flowing outline. Not in his best coat. Good movement. 3 Clough-Diprose Auberswell Star Trooper

LD (7, 2) 1 Hawkins & Foy Beldones Just A Hunch 2-year-old with a quality head with gentle rounded muzzle, good eye and ears. I liked his size and balance he moved well. 2 Fenton Shannmie's Cartier 3-year-old tri who scored in his good action front and rear. Not in his best coat. I preferred head of the winner. 3 Parker Edglonion Prime Target with Tolarock

OD (14, 1) A wonderful class full of quality and it took some time to sort out. Top 7 in the last cut all appealed despite a variety of type. 1 Mitchell Ch Valdosta Gracelands JW 4-year-old sable/white in excellent coat. Held his flowing outline at all times. Refined, quality head, good ribcage and well let down in rear. I liked his croup and tail set giving flow to his outline. This won him the DCC 2 Pearson Ch Edglonion Golden Graham 6-year-old sable with a beautiful head and expression. He has lovely balance and moved well. RDCC 3 Brady & Lynn Ch Afterglow Sky Miles to Bordercot

VD (2, 0) 1 Goodwin Highbrook Hobnob JW 8-year-old sable/white of good proportions, bone and feet. Quality head. Moved with a good stride and scored in croup here. 2 Sutherland Shougies Starmaker at Suthesley 8-year-old with beautiful head and expression. Today not covering the ground as well as the winner.

SB (3, 1) 1 Jackson Kishdigra An Irish Blessing for Clairavelle (IKC) 19-month-old of good shape. Well-constructed with particularly good rear giving her good drive. Scored in head qualities and her correct croup and quarters. BSBIB 2 Clough Evad Lite Breeze 5-year-old refined dog who could be more masculine in head. Croup is a little flat.

MPB (3, 1) 1 Mettan-Ure Savendie Highland Lullaby 8-month-old she has excellent movement and was full of confidence in her carriage. Feminine head with good skull, eye and ears but can develop a little more fill in muzzle. Should develop well. 2 Sapsford Shelcrest Band of Gold 8-month-old. I liked her shape standing and she has a pretty head but she needs more confidence on the table and on the move.

PB (5, 2) 1 Whelan & Young Edglonian Dolly Mixture at Corimist 10-month-old feminine and balanced. Her lack of coat accentuated her good, flowing body lines. Scored in head and movement here. Balanced for her size and with lovely temperament. 2 Fisher Shellamoyed Secret Love 10-month-old, more mature than the winner and in full bloom. Looked the winner standing but her front action needs to firm up. Good skull, muzzle needs to develop. 3 Goodwin Highbrook Hint of Honey

JB (2, 1) 1 Pearson Edglonian Norma Jean 17-month-old beautiful head and eye and built on flowing lines. Needs more confidence on the move.

YB (6, 1) 1 Stafford Rannerdale Coco Pop 20-month-old good winner here. Lovely lines and movement with lovely head. Would like just a little more leg for perfect balance flowing movement. RBCC 2 Jackson Kishdigra An Irish Blessing for Clairavelle (IKC) repeat 3 O'connell Kishdigra Atomic Goddess of Sionnachdu (IKC)

PGB (10, 2) 1 Stafford Rannerdale Sugar Puff 20-month-old lovely movement and flowing lines. I'd prefer a little more leg but scored in movement. 2 Thomas Myter Luna Eclipse 3-year-old tri lovely size and I liked her head. A little heavy in body which spoils the balance. Very good movement. 3 Smee Wansvale Beyond Belief **LB** (9, 5) 1 Robinson Dippersmoor Dazzling Star JW 2-year-old. Shaded sable. Scored here in topline and stride. I'd prefer a little more leg for perfect balance. 2 Hayhurst Keycharm Sweet Candy 3-year-old. A lovely bitch with beautiful head and proportions. Carrying too much weight which showed in her topline which decide this class. 3 Lewthwaite & Stafford Rannerdale Queen of Majic

OB (7, 3) 1 Robinson Ch Lavika Lateca 4-year-old comfortable winner of this class. Made a lovely outline and topline on the move. Front action can be cleaner. Feminine head that could have a little more fill in muzzle. BCC & BOB 2 Stafford Rannerdale Queen of The Nite 3-year-old tri with lovely head. She was carrying too much body today and this showed in her topline. 3 Pearson Ch Edglonian Apricot Lil

VB (5, 2) 1 Robinson Ch Lavika Black Beauty JW VW 9-year-old tri. Lovely type and best movement. BVIB 2 Mettan-Ure Valdosta Dare to Dream of Savendie blue merle has retained her good colour. Too much weight on her today and this showed in topline 3 Welford Ch Ristine Emerald VW
