

BORDER UNION CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW 13TH JUNE 2026

Many thanks for the Exhibitors for their entries and tolerating the extremely windy conditions, and the Society for the Initiation, my two Stewards were super-efficient so thanks go to them too. Obviously due to the severe wind gusts this did affect outlines some of the time and coat presentations so I was mindful of this when stood on the ground. Looking at the catalogue, I gave the Sire to several class winners and placings last time I judged, also gave the DCCs dam as a youngster a good placing and said shall watch with interest. The BCC again was out of a previous Ch. Dam placed 2nd in Open, Judging appointment, and BPIB was a granddaughter of a BCC Winner. Congratulations on BOB being shortlisted in a Strong Pastoral Group Well done slightly spooked by inconsiderate caged dogs at ringside barking in final run off back to line up. So through this entry were 3 prevalent Sires, Golden Graham, Gold Fever and Black Shadow, Dams, Slack Alice, Queen of the Dark, I did find a lot of short tails not reaching hocks at all in bone. Still a few rounder eyes.

MPD (2) Here placed accordingly 1 Shanaburn Tunes of Glory (Brodie & Raithel) 8 mths Dark expressive eye ample neck chest developing well. Well-presented jacket front movement a shade high in lift coming towards at this stage 2 Ladyoluss Dunbarton's Reme (Macdonald) 6 mths Sable preferred many of his attributes head shape and eye with good feet. Jacket in good order moved well, testes still mobile today.

PD (2) Nithview The Driffter (Melvin & Jopson) 11 ½ mths. Head and skull developing well dark eye using ears well. Good bite, nice length of neck and front assembly brisket developing well preferred the length of loins than 2 and coupling length. Nice sweep to croup and tail set. Moved out well for and aft and side gait well-presented jacket. 2 Cocaro Van Helsing (Hill) Sable presented in good jacket. 10 mths. Developing well in head with good bite, eye dark. Longer in couplings and loins, ample depth of chest. Nice tail length and tidy hocks had a positive gait.

JD (3,1) 1 Grandgenes Panning for Gold (Mr Guy Jeavons) 14 mths. Masculine shape and size on the stand in a wealth of quality jacket, with a good ruff and mane. Lovely wedge to head and ear set with good tipping and usage. Eye expressive and dark, nice taper to muzzle with clean bite. Nice arch to neck and fit into well laid front assembly Good ribbing and spring. Firm top line and loin's nice sweep to croup and tail set and low carriage, stands on good oval feet and neat tidy hocks. Moving had a smooth balanced gait with good drive off hocks covering ground with ease. DCC. 2 Vidlinvoe Vettriano (Robertson) Sable Half brother to 1. Lighter brown eye, head nice overall shape and set to ears, with desired tipping. Ample reach neck into front assembly and chest depth. Stands on slightly more rounded feet. Moved out quite well in the gusty wind. Well-presented jacket. Higher tail set and carriage than 1. 3 Ferngrove's Topaz at Gordchelly (Leaver & Wright)

YD (7,1) 1 Grandgenes Panning for Gold (Jeavons) Winner of last class. 2 Rannerdale Jammy Dodger (Stafford). 20 mths Masculine outline on the stand, richly coloured and shading. Lovely wedge to head and skull flat and good ratios to muzzle with good bite. Eye is dark and soulful used ears well. Neck lovely arch and front angles chest has depth and good elbow fit, firm back nice bend to stifles and neat hocks sweep to croup and tail set low with good carriage. Moved well when settled love to see him without the wind distracting him should make up easily. See he's littermate to BCC 3 Edglonian Edge of Glory of Vidlinvoe (Robertson)

ND (2,1) 1 Shanaburn Tunes of Glory (Brodie & Raithel) Placed 1st in MPD.

GD (6,2) 1 Katiedale Golden Ticket (Nabbs) Sable 2 ½ yrs. Lovely size make and shape on the stand. Well-presented jacket. Good wedge shape to head and ear set and tipping using well. Eye dark and expressive, good bite. Ample neck into well placed front assembly and good ribbing, firm in back nice sweep to croup and good low set tail and carriage. Stands on oval feet and neat hocks covered the ground fluidly keeping shape and balance. 2 Vidlinvoe Vettriano (Robertson) BI/White Nice proportions to skull and muzzle shape with good bite and dentition. Eye is dark lovely shape and soulful. Nice arch to neck and well lard shoulder. Chest has depth and loins firm with sweep to croup

and set to tail with low carriage, stands on oval feet and neat tidy hocks moved out well from all angles keeping shape. Well present jacket. 3 Ferngrove's Topaz at Gordchelly (Leaver & Wright) PGD (5,2) 1 Seavall Blue Ensign (Hardman & Carter) Merle 3 ¼ yrs. Well-presented jacket and good outline on the stand, nice head proportions and soulful dark and speckled eyes. Alert ear usage Good bite. Ample reach to neck and front assembly. Depth to chest, firm loins, nice bend to stifles and hocks, tail set well with low carriage. Moved out with balance and fluidity. 2 Moving On Up to Molson (Bird & Caden) 2 yrs. Sable Slightly out of coat today but nice head proportions dark eye using ears alertly. Good bite. Nice reach of neck and front. Firm loins sweep to croup giving low tail set and carriage moved out well for and good side gait. 3 Interstellar Bohemia Classic (Imp Cze) (Glencross)

LD (11) Here in this class wind was intense and was affected some in fluidity and balance. 1 Beldones Just A Hunch (Hawkins & Foy) 2 ½ yrs. Sable in a quality jacket. Masculine size make and shape on the stand. Lovely wedge head with flat skull and set and usage of ears. Eye is dark and good shape with soulful expression, nice taper to muzzle gives good bite. Arch to neck and ruff, well placed front angles and lay to shoulder. Chest has depth and tidy elbow fit, Firm loins nice sweep to croup, tail set low giving good carriage. Stands on oval feet and neat tidy hocks. Moved with balances and fluidity covered ground with ease to take the class easily. RDCC will make up easily. 2 Shannmie's Cartier (Fenton) 3 ¼ yrs. Tri Dark expressive almond eye good head ratios and bite. Well placed ears using well. Nice length to neck and good front good and ribbing nice feet, firm loins sweep to croup with low tail set and carriage. Moved out freely with positive ground covering action. 3 Grandgenes Play The Game JW (Jeavons)

OD (7) 1 Lovely quality class here 1 Ir Ch Kishdigra Rock The Heavens (Keeling) Sable. Super-size make and shape and masculine in outline. Head has good ratios, wedge shape, taper to muzzle and good bite, eye dark and good shape, Ears set on flat skull used well and alertly. Neck has arch and front has nice lay to shoulders and ribbing, stands on good oval feet, firm loins and sweep to croup and tail set low so compact in shape. Neat firm hocks gives a powerful drive and front reach covered ground easily. 2 Ch. Rannerdale Mister Majic (Stafford) Another quality masculine well boned lad. Lovely overall head shape with flat skull and set to ears with good tipping. Eye is dark and almond shape, taper to muzzle gives good bite. Neck has arch and ruff to jacket. Brisket deep and good elbow fit. Firm in back and loins, nice bend of stifle and sound tidy hocks moved out well with balanced fluid action, just a tad longer in loins than 1. Another day could change place easily. 3 Ch. Afterglow Sky Miles to Bordercot (Brady & Lynn)

VD (1) 1 Shougies Starmaker at Suthesley (Sutherland) 8 yr Tri. Nice size and shape overall not too happy in the wind today. Lovely dark eye and bite. Alert in ear usage, chest had depth and firm top line good tail set and carriage, moved out quite well here.

MPB (3) Pathaaron Lucky Clover (Mrs J Redpath) Almost 9 mths. Sable Nice size make and shape and developing well at this stage Using ears well, dark eye and good bite. Brisket coming on well as it muscling, nice croup moved out well. 2 Ladyoluss Pipes of Scotland (Macdonald) 6 mths One that needs more ring practice but will come has nice proportions overall moved a little unsure but conditions weren't ideal for a first show weatherwise. 3 Shenachie Merry Dawn (Main)

PB (3) 1 Mohnesee Ria'ly A Dream (Hateley) BPB BPIB 11 mths. Sable Feminine size and shape with nice bone. Head developing well for ratios and proportions ears used alertly, eye almond shape and expressive, nice arch to neck good front assembly chest developing well firm loins and sweep to croup with low set tail and good length and carriage. Moved out fluidly and balanced from all angles Well-presented pleased to award BPB and Later BPIB Shall watch her progress. 2 Jaelis Mystique Realism (Ritchie) Another quality feminine puppy Rich sable and non-blaze to wedge shaped head alert ears usage, eye almond and dark. Nice reach of neck and good front angles chest coming on well, body starting to firm. Nice bend of stifles and sound hocks moved out well for and aft keeping shape. 3 Edglonian Dolly Mixture at Corimist (Whelan & Young)

JB (5,2) 1 Edglonian Norma Jean (Pearson) 17 ½ mths. Destined for top honours. Feminine in outline well-presented sable jacket. Lovely wedge shape to head flat skull and good ear set and alertly used, eye dark and expressive. Good bite. Nice arch to neck Well laid in should and tidy elbows. Firm body and good depth to brisket. Good loins and croup graceful sweep give low set tail of good length and carriage. Neat hocks and oval feet, moved out well keeping balance and shape. Even if wind had other ideas. 2 Jaelis Mystique Realism (Ritchie) 2 in PB 3 Holamber Gold Blonde Diva (Sutherland)

YB (5,2) 1 Rannerdale Coco Pop (Stafford) 20 mths Feminine silhouette in size and shape on the stand in quality well- presented jacket. Skull is flat with small well set ears used attentively, nice wedge overall muzzle has a nice taper with good dentition. Eye dark and set obliquely. Neck has a slight arch and fits into well laid shoulders, tidy elbows and brisket and ribbing coming on well, firm loins and gently sweep to croup tail has length and low set and good carriage, stands on lovely oval feet and sound hocks. Moved out with a purpose balanced fluid gait keeping a proud head carriage. Should make up easily. BCC BOB Well done on being shortlisted in a strong group. Must be proud of this litter. 2 Kishdigra Atomic Goddess of Sionnachdu (IKC) (O'connell) Richly coloured, Feminine slightly longer cast in couplings than 1. Not quite 2 yrs. Head proportion developing well, good bite. Ample front assembly and chest at this stage. Nice bend of stifles and hocks, moved out with ease. 3 Shenachie Bubbles (Main)

NB (2) Interesting class. 1 Felthorn Girl Friday at Gordchelly (Leaver & Wright) Tri 6 yrs. Good head markings and overall shape like more tipping to ears, good bite. Moving had a better stride pattern than 2. 2 Holamber Gold Caramel Candy (Sutherland) Tad course in head for me, with wider set to ears, bite could be better. Longer cast in couplings and loins. Needs to strengthen in front pasterns and rear action for me.

GB (3,1) Cocaro Contraband for Molson (Hill) Tri 28 mths Feminine make and shape on the stand, nice wedge to head and ear placement, eye soulful look, good bite. Nice reach to neck and depth to brisket, stands on good feet and hocks nice tail length and carriage moved out well. 2 Felthorn Girl Friday at Gordchelly (Leaver & Wright) 2nd from Novice **PGB (5)** 1 Mad About You with Molson (Hill) Sable 3 1/ yrs. Made a good shape on the stand a little edgy in the windy conditions, well-presented jacket. Overall head proportions and wedge to muzzle good bite. Ample neck and front assembly. Depth to brisket and firm body, nice bend of stifles. Moved out steadily but a little uptight in the wind. 2 Letterikhills River Star over Torriglen JW (Saunders) Sable Slightly longer cast than 1 on the stand. Nice head shape and ear set well and tipping, dark eye, good bite. Ample length to neck and front assembly Depth to chest. Stands on oval feet and tidy hocks, moving covered the ground well. 3 Richmaus Daisy Delight (Brodie & Raithel)

LB (9,1) Mohnesee's Meliya JW (Hateley) Tri 3 yrs. Mature feminine size make and shape lovely head proportions and shape, flat skull and high set ears and used attentively, almond dark eye, nice taper to muzzle with good bite. Nice graceful arch to neck well angled and laid shoulders. Depth to chest and tidy elbow fit. Firm top line and loins, gentle sweep to croup giving low set tail and good length and carriage. Stood on oval feet and sound tidy hocks moved effortlessly retaining balance and shape. RBCC 2 Sandwich A La Mode (Hardy) Tri4 ½ yrs. Similar size make and shape to 1 just a tad steeper in croup. Lovely expressive eye set obliquely. Using well set ears. Neck has length and nice front assembly depth to chest, stands on nice oval feet. Good bend to stifles and hocks give positive movement. 3 Shellamoyed Black Lace White Tri

OB (,3) Ch. Edglonian Apricot Lil (Pearson) 2 ½ yrs. Sable, Feminine size make and shape in well-presented quality jacket. Lovely head shape with flat skull ears set well and alert usage, Eye dark with good pigment, nice taper to muzzle giving good bite. Neck gently arched and fits into well laid shoulders brisket has depth with tidy elbow fit, stands on oval feet, Top line is firm and good rear assembly and sweep over croup with nice set and length to tail and carriage. Moves with a fluid balanced stride kept her shape well in the windy conditions. Not surprised she is titled. 2 Rannerdale Queen of The Nite (Stafford) 3 yrs. Tri another quality feminine shape size and boned, in a wealth of quality jacket. Skull flat with good muzzle shape and proportions and bite. Eye dark and expressive. Neck slight arching and well laid in shoulders, brisket has depth and tidy fit to elbow stood on oval

feet. Loins firm and nice croup and set to tail with good length reaching hock. Nice bend of stifles moved out with an air of positivity covering the ground with ease, another destined no doubt for top honours. 3 Molson Mine Till Midnight (Hill)

VB (4) Sonymer Storm Doris Into Pathaaron JW (Redpath) Tri 9 ¼ Totally belying her years and credit to owner. Lovely feminine head shape and markings and still good dentition, eye dark and soulful. Nice length to neck, well laid shoulders, good depth to chest standing on good feet. Firm body nice bend to stifle. Moved out well for and aft still covering the ground easily. BVIB Well done 2
Bramblecroft Reeba at Bluequarry (Shaw) Sable 8yrs Nice outline, Ear set a shade wide for me, dark eye and nice taper to muzzle with good bite. Moved out well for and aft in a good jacket. 3 Molson Movie Star (Hill)
