I would like to thank the committee for the invitation to judge and for their hospitality. It was a great pleasure to have such a big entry with so many quality dogs! Unfortunately, the very strong winds shaking the tent and ring barriers very hard made some dogs unsettled.

Special Beginners B (2,1) 1 Simpson's Highbrook Hotpants. A girl with very good proportions and outline. Pretty head and sweet expression. Good level back and correctly set tail. Moderate angulation. Moved and showed well. Not in the best coat today.

MPD (1) 1 Rennison's Zaniah's Remember Me. Small boy. Head still needs to flatten in skull and fill out a bit in foreface. Dark almond-shaped eye. Ears a bit unsettled today. Good neck. Enough spring of ribs for his age. Moderate angulation. Moved okay. Coat of good texture.

PD (3) 1 Hill's Cocaro Van Helsing For Molson. A well-balanced dog with excellent outline. Nice head and expression. Almond-shaped eye. Well-set ears. Good spring of ribs. Excellent forechest. Very well-angulated and moved effortlessly around the ring. In good coat of correct texture. 2 Fisher's Shellamoyed Secret Blend. An eye-catching dog. Lovely wedge-shaped head. Beautiful dark eye. Correct ear placement. Long arched neck. Good spring of ribs. Well-angulated. Moved very well. Beautiful coat condition. Preferred the length of body of number one. 3 Whitchurch's Emmaview Lord Of The Rings.

JD (4,1) 1 Atkin's Estremere Silver Storm. Masculine, of correct size. Wedge-shaped head that has a good underjaw. Nice eye. A bit heavy ears. Good neck and level back. Correctly set tail. Very good substance in body. Good bone and feet. Moved well around the ring. Good merle colour. Coat of correct texture. 2 Walker's Cuilshelties Touch Of Class With Grandgenes. An eye-catching dog with the most beautiful merle colour. Head a bit round in skull. Ears slightly wide-set. Excellent neck and back. Good spring of ribs. Good tail carriage. Well-angulated. Moved freely and with very good reach. Very close to the winner. 3 Mitchell's Valdosta Je Amour.

PGD (7,1) 1 Naulls's Wynele Final Impact. Masculine dog of lovely quality. Beautiful topline. Wedge-shaped head with dark eyes gives a lovely expression. Small ears on top. Very good forechest and spring of ribs. Excellent angulation and moved with good long stride. Presented in beautiful condition. 2 Dillon's Lundecock's Tempest In A Pot At Runforest. Masculine head with nice flat skull. Almond-shaped dark eye and well-set ears. Lovely expression. Long neck. Good spring of ribs. Well-angulated with good bone and nice feet. Moved with steady free action. Today not in the best of coat but of a good texture. 3 Norris's Ferngrove's Code Blue JW.

LD (9) 1 Stafford's Rannerdale Jammy Dodger. A quality dog of correct size. Lovely head and dark almond-shaped eyes give a wonderful soft expression. Beautiful long arched neck. Level back and low-set tail. Body with very good substance and a really good forechest. Moved with good stride fore and aft. Presented in excellent coat of very good texture. 2 Parker's Edglonian Prime Target With Tolarock. Male of good size. Masculine head of good shape. Nicely shaped dark eye and well-placed ears. Good neck, well-bodied and correctly set tail. Presented in very good coat and condition. Covered the ring with good, graceful stride. 3 Bywater's Nor Ch Alucia Glee's Victorious Act With Tachnamadra.

OD (11) 1 Pearson's Ch Edglonian Golden Graham. A quality male of very good size and shape. Excellent proportions. Lovely head shape and correctly set dark eye. Beautiful expression. Well-placed semi-erect ears, very good neck, shoulder and ribs. Good bone and feet. Level topline, well-angled rear with nice short hocks. Low-set tail with good carriage. Sound and balanced mover with very good reach. Presented in excellent coat and body condition. RCC. 2 Norris's Ch Ferngrove's Valentino JW. Another quality male. Head of very good shape. Dark eye slightly rounded. Well-placed ears of good size. Good topline, level back and correctly set tail. Ribcage of good length and good substance in body. Moved with a long stride very soundly. Well presented in good condition. 3 Stafford's Rannerdale Mister Magic.

VD (5,1) 1 Stafford's Rannerdale Showmaster JW. This dog stood out for his overall quality. The most beautiful head with a lovely well-rounded foreface, correct stop and flat skull. Almond-shaped dark eye and well-set ears make his expression just wonderful! Lovely topline and well-set tail. Excellent forechest and spring of ribs. Excellent hindquarters with short hocks. He moved with drive, soundly and covered ground very well. Presented in excellent condition and in good coat of correct texture. CC and BOB. 2 Goodwin's Highbrook Hobnob JW. Another dog full of quality. Correct size. Masculine. In good condition for his eight years of age. Body with very good substance. Nice head and expression. Well-set ears. Well-bent stifle and short hocks. Sound movement with very good reach. Very good coat condition. 3 Pettitt's Mohnesee's Dream Date Of Lizmark JW.

MPB (5,1) 1 Naulls's Jenny Wren. Lovely baby! Has a really nice head with wonderful dark almond-shaped eyes that give a beautiful expression. Very good body for age. Long neck and correct topline. Well-angulated and nice short hocks. Moves with drive. 2 Winfield's Oakcroft Copacabana. Puppy with very good proportions. Good size. Excellent head and expression. Nice outline and correctly set tail. Good spring of ribs. Very good shoulder and upper arm. Excellent mover. Not too happy with the very strong wind today. 3 Walker's Tooralie's Fortune Teller.

PB (6,1) 1 Fisher's Shellamoyed Secret Love. Pretty girl. Head needs to fill out slightly more in foreface. Almond-shaped dark eyes. Ears on top. Long arched neck. Good forechest and length of ribcage. Well-angulated. Good reach on the move. Very good coat texture. 2 Hateley's Mohnesee's Ria'ly A Dream JW. Excellent size and overall proportions. Wedge-shaped head with good underjaw. Dark eyes and well-set ears. Lovely reach of neck and level back. Very good substance in body. Moves well. Not in the best of coat today. 3 Ritchie's Jaelis Mystique Realism.

JB (4,3) 1 Goodwin's Highbrook Hint Of Honey. Lovely shape. Very pretty head with well-rounded foreface. Dark eyes and well-set ears. Long neck. Good body. Well-bent stifle and short hocks. Moves with good reach and drive. Coat of good texture.

PGB (10,2) 1 Thomas's Myter Lunar Eclipse. Lovely shape. She is a bit strong in head. Beautiful dark eyes. Ears that she carries on top of her head. Long neck and proud head carriage. Well-made body and angulation. Moves easily around the ring with very good drive. Single-tracking. Coat in full bloom. 2 Miles's Milesend Silver Moth. A quality bitch of good size. Nice head. Would have liked a darker eye. Well-set ears. Moderate length of neck. Level back and correct tail carriage. Good forechest and spring of ribs. Well-bent stifle. Moves with drive. Lovely merle colour. 3 Stafford's Rannerdale Touch Of Magic.

LB (11,5) 1 Stafford's Rannerdale Coco Pop. A quality bitch. Feminine with lovely outline. Beautiful head, dark almond-shaped eyes and well-set ears give her the desirable sweet expression. Long arched neck. Strong back and correctly set tail. Very sound body. Excellent shoulder and upper arm. Good bend of stifle and short hocks. Covers the ground effortlessly on the move. RCC. 2 Miles's Milesend Black Ribbon. A beautiful tri with excellent proportions. Wedge-shaped head with flat skull, dark eye and well-set ears. Long arched neck. Very good spring of ribs and forechest. Well-angulated both in front and behind. Excellent single-tracking movement. In beautiful coat and condition. Close to the winner. 3 Goodwin's Rannerdale Honey Bee At Highbrook.

OB (13,5) 1 Robinson's Ch Lavika Lateca. A stunning bitch! Excellent head. Nice expression. Correctly set ears. A long arched neck makes her carry her head proudly. Correct back and very good sweep over the loin. Excellent, sound body. Correct shoulder and upper arm angulation. Very good bend of stifle and nice short hocks. Moves around the ring so easily, very soundly and with very good reach. Coat in full bloom. In excellent condition. CC, BOS. 2 Thornley's Felthorn Good Time Girl. A quality merle. Excellent proportions. Wedge-shaped head and very good expression. Well-set ears. Very good topline and correct tail carriage. Excellent spring of ribs and good forechest. Sound angulation both in front and behind. Moves with very good reach. Good bone and feet. Beautiful merle colour well broken. 3 Hill's Molson Mine Till Midnight.

VB (8,2) 1 Hill's Molson Movie Star. Elegant sable. Pretty head and expression. Ears on top. Long arched neck and level back. Correct tail carriage. Good spring of ribs. Very good shoulder and upper

arm angulation. Moves with good reach and drive. In good coat condition. 2 Hateley's Ch Mohnessee Sweet Dreams JW VW. A very sound and balanced bitch. Beautiful head and the best of expressions. Well-set ears. Good neck and strong back. Long ribcage and excellent forechest. Well-angulated. Very good reach and drive on the move. Not in her best coat today. 3 Welford's Ch Ristine Emerald VW.
