MPD (2) 1. Pearson's Edglonian Flash Gordon NAF. Striking baby pulling out all the stops today, she had very good proportions with lovely head and skull, dark almond eyes and correct bite, neck of good length and flowing into well set shoulders, firm top-line and so sound on the move, BP. 2. Brodie/Raithel's Shanaburn Tunes of Glory. Very unlucky to meet winner today, another lovely 7 month old baby, good head, eyes and mouth, good length of neck, well set shoulders, sound rear and moved with ease.

PD (2) 1. Hill's Cocaro Van Helsing. Pretty sable/white, good head and ear set, dark almond eyes, nice bite, ears well set and used, good front assembly and straight forelegs, well bodied, sound rear end, moved out well. 2. Melvin/Jopson's Nithview The Drifter. Sweet baby with a nice head and using his ears well, sweet eyes and expression that are a lovely almond shape, good bite, neck of fair length, firm top-line, sound rear quarters, moved well.

JD (2) 1. Walker's Cuilshelties Touch of Class with Grandgenes. Lovely blue merle, still a baby in this class, lovely head and expression with flecked eyes, good neck and layback of shoulders, sound rear quarters, moved well. 2. Robertson's Vidlinvoe Vetriciano. 14 months, slightly smaller than 1 but still having many qualities, loved his head and expression, good neck and shoulders, moved well and pushed winner hard. **YD (4)** 1. Jeavons' Grandgenes Panning for Gold. Lovely 13 month old sable with a beautiful head, almond eyes and good bite, used his ears well, lovely arch to neck, well placed sloping shoulders, deep chest, sound rear quarters that he used well on the move. 2. Stafford's Rannerdale Jammy Dodger. Another beautiful male, slightly older than 1 showing well, head of good shape, dark eyes and good bite, used his ears well, nice arch of neck, firm top-line, sound on the rear, moved well. 3. Robertson's Edglonian Edge of Glory of Vidlinvoe.

PGD (7) 1. Hawkins/Foy's Beldones Just A Hunch. This young man is maturing well, good expression, dark almond eyes with plenty of pigment, correct bite, good front and straight forelegs, lovely neck and well set shoulders, sound rear giving great movement. 2. Malone's De'leila's Sheltie Amore Mio (Imp Pol). Another striking blue merle with lovely tan and white markings, although slightly smaller a very nice male, in good proportions with a lovely head, neck and well placed shoulders, sound rear, he moved well. 3. Gartland's Arcot Polished Black JW.

LD (8) 1. Jeavons' Grandgenes Play The Game JW. What a stunning sable/white of good size, truly beautiful head that was all masculine, dark almond eye, good bite and enough stop, arched neck with muscle tone that leads into well laid shoulders, good spring of rib, deep chest, top-line remained firm on the move, sound well muscled rear, excellent 1st and 2nd thighs, moved with thrust and drive, DCC. 2. Berry/Clegram's Smiddyshaw Here I Go Again. This male was so close to winner, it was a hard task as they pushed each other hard and will change places many times I am sure, lovely head, dark eyes, good stop and bite, used his ears well, nicely muscled neck and sound shoulders, very sound rear quarters that have plenty of muscle, moved with ease. 3. Stafford's Rannerdale The Tramp.

OD (7) 1. Pearson's Ch. Edglonian Golden Graham. Beautiful male showing all the time, at his peak at only 6 years old, sable and white, I liked his colour, good head that was refined, dark eyes that were almond shaped, scissor bite, used his ears all the time, muscular neck of good length flowing into well set shoulders, sound rear quarters, moved with confidence, RDCC. 2. Brady/Lynn's Ch. Afterglow Sky Miles to Bordercot. So stylish and presented to perfection, this gentleman is very smart with his elegant head, good eye shape and his stop being slight, neck of good length and leading into sloping shoulders, sound rear, moved with strong drive. 3. Stafford's Rannerdale Mister Majic.

PB (3,1) 1. Law's Cocaro She's Kryptonite. Sound and feminine, good front and feet, nice head carriage, sound all through, good eyes and bite, free movement. 2. Speirs' Sommerville Emerald Dragon. Another nice puppy that stood and showed well, good head, eyes and bite, good neck, she moved soundly.

YB (3) 1. O'Connell's Kishdigra Atomic Goddess of Sionnachdu (IKC). Very nice bitch with good clean lines, feminine head, almond eyes, good bite and well set ears, neck of sufficient length, good front

and forelegs, sound rear movement. 2. Stafford's Rannerdale Coco Pop. Nice size and proportions, head carriage is good with dark eyes and good bite, she used her ears well, nice neck and firm top-line, sound in the rear, she moved out well. 3. Sutherland's Suthesley Petunia.

PGB (5) 1. Campbell's Cuilshelties Class Act. This youngster shone on her movement with lovely conformation, good head, eyes and bite, ears set and used well, good front, forelegs and feet, well set shoulders and her top-line was firm standing and moving, sound mover. 2. O'Connell's Sionnachdu First Of Her Name. This lady pushed the winner hard, pretty head and expression, lovely dark eyes, good ear set and ears that she used very well, good neck and shoulders, she had very sound rear giving good movement. 3. Hayhurst's Keycharm Samba.

LB (3) 1. Lewthwaite/Stafford's Rannerdale Queen of Majic. This bitch has very sound movement, good head and well set ears that she used well, dark eyes and correct bite, nice neck and shoulder placement, sound rear quarters. 2. Hayhurst's Keycharm Sweet Candy. Good size with a sweet head and dark eyes, good stop, correct bite, nice neck and shoulders with a sound rear, moved well, presented in good coat. 3. Redpath's Pathaaron Fair Isle.

OB (4) 1. Pearson's Ch. Edglonian Golden Glow. What a stunner, so beautiful and elegant, fabulous head, dark eyes, correct stop and good bite, excellent front and straight forelegs, the length of neck is so in keeping with her size, enough muscle and arch flowing into well set sloping shoulders, firm top line that she retains on the move, her movement is graceful, she is sound and in superb condition, pleased to see that she was awarded the Pastoral Group, BCC & BOB. 2. Jeavons' Ch. Wylwind Designed for Grandgables (imp SAF) JW. The decision between 2nd and 3rd was a hard one as both bitches had so many excellent points but the 2nd won on her shape and style which was of the highest quality, her extremely gorgeous head and expression was the deciding factor for me with her lovely front and straight forelegs, well arched neck, her sound rear gave strong movement with thrust and drive, RBCC. 3. Stafford's Rannerdale Queen of The Nite.

VB (3) 1. Redpath's Sonymer Storm Doris into Pathaaron JW. What a lovely lady for her age and presented in fabulous condition and moving out with such energy, lovely head and expression, good neck and shoulders, firm top-line for her age, sound rear quarters, BV. 2. Mikolajczak's Pigramik Grace Gloria. Another great lady for her age who was presented in grand condition, moving and showing well, lovely head, eyes and mouth, neck of good length into well set shoulders, good rear. 3. Shaw's Bramblecroft Reeba at Bluequarry.

SpBB (4) 1. Law's Cocaro She's Kryptonite. Repeat. BSpB. 2. Speirs' Sommerville Emerald Dragon. Repeat. 3. Saunders' Letterikhills River Star over Torriglen JW.
