

## SCOTTISH KENNEL CLUB GENERAL CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW 17<sup>TH</sup> MAY 2026

**JD (2)** 1 Cuilshelties Touch of Class with Grandgenes (Walker), a blue merle of good coat and colour, pleasing head and eye, could use ears better, good front with straight forelegs and oval feet, well-proportioned body, strong loin and muscled quarters, correct tail set and carriage, showed well; 2 Vidlinvoe Vetriciano (Robertson), sweet head and alert expression, well-constructed front with good arch to neck, tight feet and correct bone, well-made body, super coat and texture, not quite the balance of the winner, nice side gait though slightly cow-hocked behind

**YD (4)** 1 Grandgenes Panning for Gold (Jeavons), good masculine head, well-placed small ears and dark expressive eyes, straight front and good shoulders, balanced body with good ribs and strong loin, coat fits perfectly and very sound both ways; 2 Edglonian Edge of Glory of Vidlinvoe (Robertson), lovely head for quality and balance, well-placed ears and correct eye, preferred shoulders on the winner, super well-knit body, muscled quarters, in good jacket and showed well; 3 Rannerdale Jammy Dodger (Stafford);

**PGD (4)** 1 Beldones Just a Hunch (Hawkins & Foy), slightly strong in head but with good ears and lovely eyes, super body shape and ample bone, correct oval tight feet, good arched neck into well-laid shoulders and neat elbows, well-bent stifle, shown in super coat and sound; 2 Moving On Up to Molson (Bird & Caden), not as settled as the winner, super breed type, preferred head on this dog, not overdone with well-placed ears and eye giving correct expression, preferred front construction on the winner, solid body and well-made rear, sound both ways, close decision; 3 Pigramik Radamantys Rex (Mikolajczak);

**LD (9)** 1 Grandgenes Play The Game JW (Jeavons), a deceiving dog and lovely to examine on the table, masculine balanced head, correct dark eye and high-set ears, straight forelegs and well-placed feet, good forechest notably lacking in many exhibits, well-laid shoulders and good depth of body, correct bone not overdone, level topline, balanced outline shown in good coat and condition, sound coming and going, preferred side gait on Bitch CC winner for BOB; 2 Smiddyshaw Here I Go Again (Berry & Clegam), super shape and size, preferred head on the winner as ears slightly heavy, lovely front and rear construction, arched proud neck, good ribs and strong loin, showed well and very sound, shown in good well-fitting coat, awarded RDCC; 3 Edglonian Prime Target with Tolarock (Parker);

**OD (5)** 1 Ir Ch Kishdigra Rock The Heavens (Keeling), very difficult class with differing types, this dog won on movement, lovely head with well-placed dark eye, super front and rear construction, arched neck, neat elbows and correct medium-strong bone, level topline and correct tail carriage, coat fits well; 2 Ch Afterglow Sky Miles to Bordercot (Brady & Lynn), blue merle of good colour and texture, super breed type though not front-moving like the winner, excellent showman, pleasing head, straight forelegs and neat feet, correct bone and substance, super topline and tail set, lovely quarters, sound rear movement and profile, close decision; 3 Rannerdale Mister Majic (Stafford);

**Special Beginners D (2,1)** 1 Mohnesee Mr Charming (Chorlton), lovely breed type, balanced head to body with good ears and eye, neat front and nice forechest, good depth of brisket, level topline, showed well in good jacket, awarded Best Special Beginner

**PB (3,1)** 1 Cocaro She's Kryptonite (Law), two fine examples of the breed standard, feminine head with good ears when settled, well-placed dark eye, sufficient bone for size, compact body and good ribs, level topline, well-bent stifles, showed well; 2 Sommerville Emerald Dragon (Speirs), tricolour with good rich tan, larger mould and less compact but lovely to examine, pleasing head and expression, neat ears, good shoulder placement and level topline, lovely quarters and sound on the move, close decision

**YB (3)** 1 Rannerdale Coco Pop (Stafford), lovely to examine with good head proportions, correct dark eye and well-placed ears, excellent front assembly with neat feet, straight forelegs, solid body, level topline and correct tail carriage, super active sound mover, good coat texture fitting well; 2 Kishdigra Atomic Goddess of Sionnachdu (IKC) (O'Connell), sweet head and expression though ears not matching the winner's, super front, neat elbows, well-laid shoulders and good return of upper arm,

sufficient bone, well-sprung ribs carried back, level topline, good quarters and neat rear pasterns, sound on the move, close decision; 3 Suthesley Petunia (Sutherland)

**PGB** (3,1) 1 Cuilshelties Class Act (Campbell), blue merle not in full coat yet of good texture, lovely head proportions, small neat ears and correct eyes, arched neck into clean shoulders, good forechest and straight front, balanced body with good topline and bend of stifle, sound mover, could carry more weight; 2 Wansvale Beyond Belief (Smee), preferred head on the winner but still a good feminine head, correct eye not too small, balanced body with good front and rear angles, correct bone and oval feet, good tail carriage, showed well; 3 Sionnachdu First of Her Name (O'Connell)

**LB** (1) 1 Rannerdale Queen of Majic (Lewthwaite & Stafford), lovely breed type for quality and soundness, true coming and going with delightful side gait, sweet feminine head with well-placed ears and correct dark eyes, a pleasure to examine and beautifully balanced outline, good arched neck into clean shoulders, correct topline with good bend of stifle and strong rear pasterns, considered for top honours

**OB** (4,1) 1 Ch Edglonian Golden Glow (Pearson), a truly beautiful girl, feminine yet strong, sweetest head with lovely expression, neatest ears, super clean arched neck into well-laid shoulders and lovely return of upper arm, excellent front construction with ample bone, straight forelegs and neat oval feet, compact solid body, level topline and strong loin, excellently muscled quarters, carries tail well, shown in excellent coat and condition, awarded BCC and BOB; 2 Molson Mine Till Midnight (Hill), another lovely example oozing quality, lovely head and sweet expression, good bone and neat feet, super body shape with clean outline, arched neck into good shoulders and topline, lacks the winner's forechest slightly, sound mover and showed well, awarded RBCC; 3 Ch Wylwind Designed for Grandgables (Imp Saf) JW (Jeavons)

**VB** (2) 1 Bramblecroft Reeba at Bluequarry (Shaw), lovely to examine, pretty well-proportioned head, ample neck, correct bone and neat oval feet, straight forelegs, good forechest, clean well-laid shoulders, good spring of rib and strong loin, correct tail set and carriage, showed well with sound active movement, in good jacket, awarded Best Veteran; 2 Pigramik Grace Gloria (Mikolajczak), another good-headed bitch with alert expression, neat ears and dark eyes, good front with depth of body, clean arched neck though less compact than the winner, super rear construction and sound moving with drive, not in full coat condition

**Special Beginners B** (3) 1 Bramblecroft Reeba at Bluequarry (Shaw); 2 Letterikhills River Star over Torriglen JW (Saunders), lovely feminine head with well-placed ears and eyes, balanced compact body and good forechest, super ribs and quarters, harsher coat, good rear and profile movement, preferred front movement on the winner but close decision; 3 Cocaro She's Kryptonite (Law)

**Good Citizen Dog Scheme B** (2) 1 Letterikhills River Star over Torriglen JW (Saunders); 2 Sommerville Emerald Dragon (Speirs).
